***FREE Wi-Fi Available at All Kern County Library Branches***

Kern County Library (KCL) has received additional funding from the Board of Supervisors (BOS) in Fiscal Year 2015/2016 to be allocated for Wi-Fi at all KCL branches. The expansion in service will provide Library customers with more opportunities to access high speed internet for FREE at all twenty-four library locations.

Previously, a portion of KCL Branches already provided FREE Wi-Fi with funding through donations from individual Friends of the Library groups, discretionary funds from Supervisor Leticia Perez, and the Kern County Library Foundation. The additional funding means that the remaining branches throughout Kern County will all be Wi-Fi enabled.

Access to the Wi-Fi network at all KCL locations is available FREE of charge for everyone, and customers can connect without the use of a library card or access code. Customers can also access the KCL wireless network at all branches using their own devices, or enjoy FREE access to the Internet at any of the Library's desktop computers.
